REFLECTIONS ON GENEROSITY

GIVING AWAY THE PLATE - LOVE FOR THY NEIGHBOR

Again, in 2024, the "plate offering" collected each Sunday will be donated to worthwhile not-forprofit organizations in our community. (Plate offering is cash unidentified by giver). Last week, \$414 was collected for Sojourner Center. This week, the collection will be provided to Cruzando Fronteras (CF). CF is a collaboration among Episcopal, Anglican, Lutheran, and United Church of Christ churches whose mission is to provide prayer and support for humanitarian services provided along the Arizona/Sonora corridor. One of the primary services, The La Casa partner shelter, supports individuals and families as they take the next steps in the immigration process.
