FEBRUARY 1: M.D. Hawkins Homeless Veterans Center

Every day, we support more than 300 veterans experiencing homelessness, and in 2026 we opened the Phoenix M.D. Hawkins Veterans Center, providing housing stability, including a dedicated wing for women veterans. The center will eventually feature a fitness center, food pantry, drop-in center and outdoor communal areas designed to promote healing, connection and wellness.
